

Senate Bill 484

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to other state symbols, so as to declare the City of Colquitt as Georgia's First Mural  
3 City; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 WHEREAS, the mission of the Colquitt-Miller Arts Council, Inc., is to encourage, enrich,  
7 and stimulate the practice and appreciation of the arts among the people living in its  
8 geographic area; and

9 WHEREAS, the Colquitt Millennium Mural Project strives to beautify the downtown area  
10 with different styles of mural artwork and is presently at work on its tenth mural; and

11 WHEREAS, the project is intended to bond the community, create a tourism magnet,  
12 revitalize the local economy, and transfer values of the community to the next generation  
13 through the creation of public artworks; and

14 WHEREAS, the project strives to illustrate to local citizens and visitors the power of the arts  
15 as a catalyst for positive social and economic change; and

16 WHEREAS, the project will strive to develop a mural city program where other communities  
17 can learn how to implement high quality murals in their communities; and

18 WHEREAS, the project will strive to develop a Georgia Mural Trail to help educate visitors  
19 and market Georgia's murals.

**SECTION 1.**

2 Article 3 of Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to other  
3 state symbols, is amended by inserting at the end thereof a new Code section to read as  
4 follows:

5 "50-3-82.

6 (a) The City of Colquitt is designated as Georgia's First Mural City.

7 (b) The Department of Economic Development and other public agencies and leaders in  
8 the tourism industry are encouraged to work together to maximize advertising programs  
9 which permit citizens of other states and nations to learn of Georgia's First Mural City and  
10 to visit the State of Georgia for tourism purposes."

**SECTION 2.**

12 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
