## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Remembering and honoring the life of Mr. Charles R. Frierson, Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Charles "Charlie" R. Frierson, Jr., was a native of Gainesville born on April  
3 13, 1926; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Frierson was a graduate of Gainesville High School and of The Georgia  
5 Institute of Technology who served his country honorably as a staff sergeant in the United  
6 States Army in World War II, after which he had a distinguished career with  
7 Frierson-McEver Company culminating in his presidency of the business; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Frierson was an invaluable member of his community, as demonstrated,  
9 among many laudable activities, by his faithful service to First Presbyterian Church, his  
10 leadership in the Jaycees, the Chamber of Commerce, and the Rotary Club, his work for  
11 Gainesville-Hall Resource including his serving as director of the Gainesville-Hall 1996  
12 Olympics Roundtable and Merchandising, and his membership in the Northeast Georgia  
13 Medical Center Auxiliary, for which he and his wife chaired the Love Light Campaign; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Frierson leaves behind his loving and devoted family, including his wife  
15 of 55 years, Joanne Moore Frierson; his daughters and sons-in-law, Nancy and Bruce  
16 McAllister and Carol and John Thurman; his son and daughter-in-law, Chip and Leslie  
17 Frierson; his grandchildren, Brian and Elizabeth McAllister Coates, Meg McAllister, and  
18 Charlie McAllister; and his sister, Martha Frierson Walker; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost a most estimable citizen on July 16, 2005, with the  
20 passing of Mr. Charles R. Frierson, Jr.
