## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to authorize the General Assembly to
- 2 provide by general or local law for limitations upon the rate of increase of the ad valorem tax
- 3 millage rate and value of property for certain purposes; to provide for the submission of this
- 4 amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article IX, Section IV of the Constitution is amended by adding a new Paragraph at the end
- 8 thereof, to be designated Paragraph V, to read as follows:
- 9 "Paragraph V. Limitations on millage rate or valuation increases. Notwithstanding any
- 10 other provision of this Constitution to the contrary, the General Assembly shall be
- authorized to provide by general or local law for any or all of the following:
- 12 (1) Limitations upon the rate of increase of the ad valorem tax millage rate for county,
- municipal, or school district purposes or any combination thereof not to exceed 3 percent
- per year; or

- 15 (2) Limitations upon the rate of increase in the value of property for ad valorem
- taxation for county, municipal, or school district purposes or any combination thereof,
- excluding any additions or improvements thereto, not to exceed 3 percent per year."

18 SECTION 2.

- 19 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 20 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution.
- 21 The ballot submitting the above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon
- 22 the following:

7	All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If	
8	such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall	
9	become a part of the Constitution of this state.
