A RESOLUTION

- 1 Remembering and honoring the life of Mr. A. Gilmore Crumpler, Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. A. Gilmore (Gil) Crumpler, Jr., was born on June 8, 1945, in Raleigh,
3 North Carolina, and grew up in the neighboring town of Fuquay-Varina; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Crumpler attended the Darlington School in Rome, Georgia, and received
5 bachelor of arts and juris doctor degrees from Wake Forest University and a master of law
6 degree from the University of Miami; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he enjoyed a prosperous career during which he worked as a vice president in
8 Wachovia Bank's trust department for several years and established his own personal
9 financial counseling firm in the mid-1990s before retiring in 2004; and
- 10 WHEREAS, a friendly and generous gentleman, Mr. Crumpler loved to bring a smile to
11 others, and he frequently volunteered alongside his Cavalier King Charles Spaniels, Hudson
12 and Kate, at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta at Scottish Rite; he also volunteered weekly as
13 a lay minister at the Shepherd Center and had served on the boards of the Tommy Nobis
14 Center, Nicholas House, and Phoenix Society; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Crumpler was a devoted and highly active parishioner at Holy Innocents'
16 Episcopal Church, where he was a member of the vestry, a chalice bearer, a member of the
17 Board of Trustees at Holy Innocents' Episcopal School, and taught English in the church's
18 English for Successful Living program; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Crumpler leaves behind a loving and devoted family, including his wife,
20 Gera-Lu S. Crumpler; his daughters, Gralyn Wood Crumpler and Marian Raine Crumpler;
21 his son, Alexander Kramer Perrin Crumpler; and his sister, Judith C. Lyon; and

2 Mr. A. Gilmore Crumpler, Jr.
