A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta and inviting them to appear before
2 the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta is celebrating its 100 year anniversary
4 as a nonsectarian, not-for-profit, nondiscriminatory community-based health and social
5 service provider; and

6 WHEREAS, as an umbrella organization to 12 separate affiliate organizations, the Jewish
7 Federation of Greater Atlanta is excelling at meeting the needs of the community by
8 providing a wide array of services for every phase of life; and

9 WHEREAS, with the aid of its dedicated staff, volunteers, and community contributors, the
10 Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta carries out its life changing work such as raising more
11 than \$420,000.00 this year in pledges for relief efforts, \$100,000.00 of which was donated
12 to the Atlanta Community Food Bank; and

13 WHEREAS, the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta's strong commitment to serving
14 children, helping people with disabilities to live independent and productive lives, and
15 providing older adults with needed homes and services is a driving force for community
16 values in the greater Atlanta area and for the State of Georgia

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 this body commends the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta for its 100 years of outstanding
19 contributions on behalf of the citizens of greater Atlanta and the State of Georgia and invites
20 them to appear before the House of Representatives at a date and time to be designated by
21 the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
