A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Samuel Aumann; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Samuel Aumann, a member of Boy Scout Troop 479 of Marietta, Georgia, has
3 successfully met all requirements for the Eagle Scout Award, which will be bestowed upon
4 him at an Eagle Court of Honor Ceremony on February 11, 2006; and

5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest
6 achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and

7 WHEREAS, only about 4 percent of all Boy Scouts earn the rank of Eagle Scout; and

8 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a Scout has developed leadership
9 abilities, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
10 of immense benefit to himself and others throughout his life; and

11 WHEREAS, in order for a Scout to reach this goal, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of
12 which are mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

13 WHEREAS, for his final accomplishment to achieve his ranking, Samuel Aumann
14 constructed 15 easels and donated the same to the Powers Ferry Elementary School for use
15 by the teachers in their classrooms; and

16 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Samuel Aumann has brought honor to himself,
17 his family, his troop, and his community.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that Samuel Aumann is
19 recognized and commended on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and he is extended the best
20 wishes of each member of this body for success and happiness in future endeavors.
