| 6 | SECTION 1. |
| 7 | Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from |
| 8 | sales and use tax, is amended by striking "or" at the end of paragraph (81); by striking the |
| 9 | period at the end of paragraph (82) and inserting in it place "; or"; and by adding a new |
| 10 | paragraph immediately following paragraph (82), to be designated paragraph (83), to read |
| 11 | as follows: |
| 12 | "(83) The sale or use of tangible personal property used in the maintenance or repair of |
| 13 | aircraft." |
| 14 | SECTION 2. |
| 15 | This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2006. |

| 17 | All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. |
