

The House Committee on Judiciary Non-civil offers the following substitute to HB 1001:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 16-11-126 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 the offense of carrying a concealed weapon, so as to change certain provisions regarding the
3 transporting of certain firearms; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 Code Section 16-11-126 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the offense
7 of carrying a concealed weapon, is amended by striking subsection (d) in its entirety and
8 inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (d) to read as follows:

9 "~~(d) This Code section shall not forbid the transportation of any firearm by a any person~~
10 ~~who is not among those enumerated as ineligible for a license under Code Section~~
11 ~~16-11-129, provided the firearm is enclosed in a case, unloaded, and separated from its~~
12 ~~ammunition. This Code section shall not forbid any person who is not among those~~
13 ~~enumerated as ineligible for a license under Code Section 16-11-129 from transporting a~~
14 ~~an unloaded or loaded firearm in any private passenger motor vehicle in an open manner~~
15 ~~and fully exposed to view or in the glove compartment, console, or similar compartment~~
16 ~~of the vehicle; provided, however, that any person in possession of a valid permit issued~~
17 ~~pursuant to Code Section 16-11-129 may carry a handgun in any location in a motor~~
18 ~~vehicle in any location in the motor vehicle."~~

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
