## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Phillip Shaw on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Phillip Shaw, of Boy Scout Troop 30 in Savannah, has earned the rank of Eagle
- 3 Scout, which will be awarded to him at an Eagle Court of Honor on March 4, 2006; and
- 4 WHEREAS, to earn this exceptional award, he earned 21 merit badges and served his troop
- 5 in a variety of leadership roles; and
- 6 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout service project, Phillip Shaw constructed a pavilion-style
- 7 covering for the children's play area at the Roundhouse Railroad Museum, modeled after the
- 8 former Central of Georgia Railroad passenger train shed; and
- 9 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
- 10 Phillip Shaw has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the many
- 11 special skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Phillip Shaw has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting principles of
- 13 honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner becoming of an
- 14 Eagle Scout; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in a world which all too often seems to dwell on the negative aspects of the
- 16 actions of young people, it is especially fitting and proper for this body to recognize the
- 17 outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 19 commend Phillip Shaw for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
- 20 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
- 21 rank of Eagle Scout.
