A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Georgia 4-H, a unit of Cooperative Extension at the
2 University of Georgia College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, and inviting
3 Mr. Cody Thomas, Dr. Roger C. (Bo) Ryles, Dr. Scott Angle, Dr. Mel Garber, and the
4 2005-2006 4H Leadership Team to appear before the House of Representatives; and for other
5 purposes.

7 necessary to be champions and serve as outstanding representatives and officers of the young
8 people of Georgia; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Cody Thomas serves with distinction and dedication as State 4-H President;

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Roger C. (Bo) Ryles, State 4-H Leader and Director of 4-H, has worked
12 diligently with Extension agents, specialists, and leaders of the 4-H Clubs throughout
13 Georgia; and

14 WHEREAS, Dr. Scott Angle and Dr. Mel Garber have provided leadership for Cooperative
15 Extension; and

16 WHEREAS, the leadership, dedication, and hard work of Asya Muhammad of McIntosh
17 County as State Vice President, Kitty Ball of Lincoln County, Abigail Lloyd of Bartow
18 County, Jordan McCoy of Bryan County, and Zenobia Williams of Seminole County as
19 District Presidents have been acknowledged by the 4-H membership in their election of each
20 of these young people to serve as president for 2005-2006; and

21 WHEREAS, the excellent record of accomplishments in citizenship and leadership of Allie
22 Chambers of Jones County, Joelle Freeman of Gwinnett County, Scottie Rowell of Heard

1 County, Luke Usry of Peach County, and Christina Waller of Oglethorpe County were
2 recognized in Washington, D.C., at the 2005 National 4-H Conference; and

3 WHEREAS, Kasey Bozeman of Pike County and Kathy Snooks of Effingham County were
4 named 2005 Teen Leadership winners; and

5 WHEREAS, Allie Chambers of Jones County, Joelle Freeman of Gwinnett County, Emily
6 Lloyd of Bartow County, Sam Raybon of Paulding County, and Christina Waller of
7 Oglethorpe County were named state winners in the 2005 Dean's Awards competition; and

8 WHEREAS, Scottie Rowell of Heard County was named a member of the National 4-H
9 Youth Technology Leadership Team; and

10 WHEREAS, Laura Leidner, Sally Smith, Austin Suggs, and Samantha Tankersley of Tift
11 County were named national winners at the National Poultry Judging Competition; and

12 WHEREAS, Anna Collins, Byron Collins, Andrew Davidson, and Sammy Hodges of
13 Crawford County were named national winners at the National Wildlife Judging
14 Competition; and

15 WHEREAS, Ashley Buford and Sandra McKinney of Crisp County were named members
16 of the National 4-H Youth Directions Council; and

17 WHEREAS, Monday, February 13, 2006, is 4-H Day at the state capitol.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body recognize and commend Georgia 4-H, a unit of Cooperative
20 Extension at the University of Georgia College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences;
21 Mr. Cody Thomas, State 4-H President; Dr. Roger C. (Bo) Ryles, Director of 4-H;
22 Dr. Scott Angle, Dean and Director of the College of Agricultural and Environmental
23 Sciences; Ms. Asya Muhammad, State 4-H Vice President; and each of the 2005-2006 4-H
24 district presidents, 2005 Dean's Awards winners, 2005 National 4-H Conference delegates,
