## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Mr. Rodney Musselman; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, for several years, Mr. Rodney Musselman has been one of the most vocal and  
3 influential promoters of tourism in the Savannah area and the State of Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Musselman is the Area Manager for Maryland Hospitality Incorporated  
5 Hotels, where he oversees properties in Savannah and on Tybee Island, including the award  
6 winning Hilton Savannah DeSoto Hotel; and
- 7 WHEREAS, among his many leadership activities within the Savannah hospitality  
8 community, Mr. Musselman is a founding member and former president of the Tourism  
9 Leadership Council, former chairman of the Savannah Taxi Board, board member of the  
10 Savannah Waterfront Association, past chairman and treasurer of the Savannah Area  
11 Convention & Visitors Bureau, trustee of the Coastal Heritage Society, and member of the  
12 Tourism Advisory Committee of Savannah; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Musselman continually strives to promote tourism not just in Savannah but  
14 throughout the entire state and was instrumental in founding the Tourism Development  
15 Alliance of Georgia, serving as chairman in 2005; and
- 16 WHEREAS, considering how valuable tourism can be to local and state economies, it is  
17 abundantly fitting and proper that this body appropriately recognize Mr. Musselman's many  
18 contributions to Savannah and to Georgia.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body join in commending Mr. Rodney Musselman for his outstanding  
21 leadership and advocacy for his industry and thank him for his work to promote tourism in
