A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 controlled substances, so as to change certain provisions relating to Schedule I controlled  
3 substances; to change certain provisions relating to Schedule IV controlled substances; to  
4 change certain provisions relating to the definition of the term "dangerous drug"; to provide  
5 an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to controlled  
9 substances, is amended in Code Section 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I controlled  
10 substances, by striking subparagraphs (O), (Z), and (SS) of paragraph (3) and inserting in  
11 their respective places the following:

12 "(O) Psilocyn (Psilocin);"

13 "(Z) 3, 4-Methylenedioxyamphetamine (MDMA);"

14 "(SS) ~~MDMA (3, 4 Methylene Dioxymethamphetamine)~~ Reserved;"

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-28, relating to Schedule IV controlled  
17 substances, by striking paragraph (33) and inserting its place the following:

18 "(33) Zolpidem;

19 (34) Zopiclone, and all salts, isomers, and salts of isomers thereof."

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-71, relating to the definition of  
22 dangerous drug, by striking paragraphs (116.05), (116.1), (193.5), (515), (663.1), and  
23 (663.75) in subsection (b) and inserting in their respective places the following:

- 1 "(116.05) ~~Buprenorphine~~ Reserved;"  
 2 "(116.1) ~~Buproprion~~ Bupropion;"  
 3 "(193.5) ~~Cinacatet~~ Cinacalcet;"  
 4 "(515) ~~Levallorphan~~ Reserved;"  
 5 "(663.1) ~~Olmesartain~~ Olmesartan;"  
 6 "(663.75) Orlistat – See exceptions;"

7 **SECTION 4.**

8 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-71, relating to the definition of  
 9 dangerous drug, by inserting new paragraphs in subsection (b) to read as follows:

- 10 "(13.53) Adalimumab;"  
 11 "(108.5) Bromfenac;"  
 12 "(243.5) Deferasirox;"  
 13 "(332.85) Entecavir;"  
 14 "(380.6) Exenatide;"  
 15 "(409.8) Galsulfase;"  
 16 "(464.7) Iloprost;"  
 17 "(513.7) Lenalidomide;"  
 18 "(544.5) Mecasermin;"  
 19 "(616.05) Micafungin;"  
 20 "(638.75) Nelarabine;"  
 21 "(640.1) Nepafenac;"  
 22 "(681.4) Palifermin;"  
 23 "(692.51) Pegfilgrastin;"  
 24 "(692.515) Peginterferon;"  
 25 "(769.3) Pramlintide;"  
 26 "(772.5) Pregabalin;"  
 27 "(831.04) Ramelteon;"  
 28 "(843.2) Risedronate;"  
 29 "(966.3) Tigecycline;"  
 30 "(967.57) Tipranavir;"

31 **SECTION 5.**

32 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-71, relating to the definition of  
 33 dangerous drug, by inserting a new paragraph in subsection (c) to read as follows:

- 34 "(16.95) Orlistat – when a single dosage unit is 60 mg. or less;"

1 **SECTION 6.**

2 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
3 without such approval.

4 **SECTION 7.**

5 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
