- Woman's Club awards annual scholarships to deserving area high school students as well as
- 17 handing out "Second Wind" scholarships for adults; and

- 19 community libraries, helping to found libraries at Dunwoody High School, Vanderlyn
- 20 Elementary School, Our House, and the Dunwoody Nature Center; and
