A RESOLUTION

- 1 Dedicating the SGT Mike Stokely Memorial Highway; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, SGT Michael "Mike" Stokely was a member of Troop E 108th Cavalry Unit
- 3 in the 48th Brigade Combat Team serving in Iraq; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mike joined the National Guard as a junior in high school in Loganville,
- 5 Georgia, and signed on for a six-year term; and
- 6 WHEREAS, SGT Stokely was on foot patrol on August 16, 2005, around the area of
- 7 Yusufiyah, Iraq, and was killed by injuries suffered when an explosive device detonated; and
- 8 WHEREAS, this courageous soldier confronted the dangers, privations, and discomforts of
- 9 striving to keep the peace in Iraq with fortitude and steadfast resolve, making us as a nation
- 10 truly proud; and
- 11 WHEREAS, all Americans owe a debt of gratitude to the men and women of our armed
- 12 forces who risk their lives in the defense of freedom and to secure the blessings of liberty for
- this nation and other peoples of the world.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 GEORGIA that the portion of SR 81 in Walton County from its intersection with US 78 to
- 16 the Newton County line be dedicated as the SGT Mike Stokely Memorial Highway, and the
- 17 Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate
- 18 markers dedicating the SGT Mike Stokely Memorial Highway.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 20 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the family of SGT Mike Stokely and to
- 21 the Department of Transportation.
