A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending George W. Bowen; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, George W. Bowen has served with distinction as chief operating officer of the
3 Savannah-Chatham County school system and also acting superintendent of schools for that
4 school system; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he has led a school district of 35,000 students in pre-kindergarten through grade
6 12 and also over 3,000 adult learners; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in so doing he has fostered numerous actions to improve the school system,
8 including development of curriculum delivery processes that stress rigor, relevance, and
9 relationships to promote excellence for students, staff, and community; new facilities plans;
10 and a comprehensive program to open lines of communication among residents, school
11 administration, and school staff; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in addition to his distinguished career as a leader in education both in
13 Savannah-Chatham County and previously in Rochester, New York, he served his country
14 as a career officer in the United States Air Force from 1965 to 1999, attaining the rank of
15 Colonel with top secret clearance and having a number of world-wide assignments; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that he be honored by this body.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body commend George W. Bowen for his distinguished public service
19 and his many contributions to the welfare of his community, this state, and this nation.
