ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the State of Georgia to work toward the passage of legislation that will establish a
- 2 system of stroke care for all state residents stricken by stroke; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, according to the American Stroke Association, strokes are the third leading
- 4 cause of death in the United States, striking about 700,000 Americans each year; and
- 5 WHEREAS, stroke is a leading cause of serious long-term disability in the United States
- 6 with about 4.8 million stroke survivors today; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in 2004 the estimated direct and indirect cost of stroke is about \$53.6 billion
- 8 dollars; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Institute of Medicine (IOM) of the National Academy of Science has
- 10 concluded that the fragmentation of the delivery of health care services frequently results in
- less than optimal treatment, safety concerns, and inefficient use of health care resources; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the IOM recommended the establishment of coordinated systems of care that
- 13 integrate preventative and treatment services and promote patient access to evidence based
- 14 care; and
- 15 WHEREAS, according to the American Stroke Association, research into a systems approach
- 16 is necessary to effectuate true change in the way stroke is treated statewide so that patients
- 17 have access to the most advanced treatment in centers that are best designed and equipped
- 18 to deal with the critical and time sensitive needs of stroke patients; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the main purpose of stroke systems legislation is to establish a systems
- 20 approach to dealing with stroke patients, including assessing center designations, EMS
- 21 protocols and field triage, interfacility stroke transfer, and stroke data collection.
