A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and recognizing Mrs. Virginia T. Peebles as the 2005 Sarah Turner Butler
2 Heritage Award Recipient.

3 WHEREAS, through her service to Historic Columbus, Mrs. Peebles has been a leader in the
4 preservation field; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Peebles has spent decades working for the betterment of Columbus as an
6 effective advocate for historic preservation, a proponent of education about local and
7 regional history, and a driving force in the effort to revitalize the historic neighborhoods of
8 Columbus; and

10 Columbus, Inc., the Board of Historic and Architectural Review, the Community Foundation

14 occasions, including a Governor's Award in the Humanities; and

17 Historic Columbus as an exemplary supporter and volunteer.
