13 Team, for which he will compete at the 2008 Olympic Games in Beijing; and

14 WHEREAS, friends and competitors alike marvel at his remarkable confidence, poise, and
15 a list of accomplishments that is highly unusual for such a young shooter; and

16 WHEREAS, thanks to his immense talent and unwavering dedication to perfection, Mr.
17 Hancock has come to dominate his sport, bringing great honor to his family and to Georgia.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body join in congratulating Mr. Vincent Hancock on his gold medal at
20 the World Shotgun Championships and his many other prestigious wins and thank him for
