

House Bill 1411

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

To amend Article 5 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 and Chapter 60 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to local school superintendents and general provisions applicable to counties and municipal corporations, respectively, so as to prohibit local school superintendents and certain elected officials of county and municipal corporations from certain employment opportunities for a period of time; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

**SECTION 1.**

Article 5 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to local school superintendents, is amended by striking repealed Code Section 20-2-102 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"20-2-102.

Any local school board superintendent shall be prohibited from being employed by the local board of education by whom the superintendent was employed for a period of one year after such employment was terminated in any manner."

**SECTION 2.**

Chapter 60 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions applicable to counties and municipal corporations, is amended by adding a new Code section to the end of the chapter to read as follows:

"36-60-24.

Any elected county official, elected member of a local board of education, or elected municipal official shall be prohibited from being employed by the entity for whom the official served for a period of one year after leaving such office; provided, however, that this restriction shall not apply to such person's being elected to office for the entity for whom the official formerly served."
