A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the City of Adel in Cook County as the "City of Daylilies"; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the City of Adel has a profusion of daylilies due to its perfect climate to grow
4 these beautiful and hardy perennials; and

5 WHEREAS, on February 6, 2006, the city council reached a consensus to change the city
6 flower to the daylily; and

7 WHEREAS, Adel desires the symbol of the daylily to be used to identify in the minds of the
8 citizens of Georgia their city; and

9 WHEREAS, daylilies are so named because each flower lasts only one day yet each plant
10 produces an abundance of flower buds that open over a long period of time; and

11 WHEREAS, there are many varieties and a wide range of flower colors that continue to
12 bloom during the heat of summer; and

13 WHEREAS, Adel desires to use these vigorous, adaptable, and enduring flowers to celebrate
14 and decorate their fair city.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
16 the members of this body recognize the City of Adel as the "City of Daylilies."

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
18 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the City of Adel.
