A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the University of Georgia Women's Swimming Team on winning the 2005
2 NCAA National Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, for the fourth time in six years, the University of Georgia Lady Bulldogs
4 Women's Swimming Team has won the NCAA National Championship; and

5 WHEREAS, Coach Jack Bauerle was named the NCAA Division I Women's College
6 Swimming Coach of the Year for the fourth time and the Southeastern Conference Women's
7 Coach of the Year for the tenth time; and

8 WHEREAS, the Lady Bulldogs claimed top honors in the 100 and 200 butterfly events, the
9 50 and 100 freestyle events, and for the first time in NCAA history, won all five relay races;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, after a stellar 9-0 season, the Lady Bulldogs were named the College Swim
12 Coaches of America Association's Women's Dual Meet Champion; and

13 WHEREAS, thanks to the hard work and perseverance of the team's extraordinary athletes,
14 the Lady Bulldogs set or matched nine school records, including three American records, two
15 U.S. Open records, and two NCAA records; and

16 WHEREAS, the Lady Bulldogs Swimming Team has brought great honor to its school and
17 state through its impressive victory at the NCAA National Championship.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 join in commending the University of Georgia Women's Swimming Team on winning the
20 2005 NCAA National Championship and congratulate the team's swimmers and coaches on
21 their outstanding athletic accomplishments.
