A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the University of Georgia Football Team on winning the 2005 Southeastern
2 Conference Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, for the second time in four years, the University of Georgia Bulldogs Football
4 Team has won the Southeastern Conference Championship; and

5 WHEREAS, this victory marks the twelfth time the Bulldogs have won this prestigious title;

7 WHEREAS, prior to that, the team won its third Southeastern Conference Eastern Division
8 Championship in the last four years; and

9 WHEREAS, thanks to the hard work and perseverance of all the team's remarkable athletes,
10 the Bulldogs finished among the nation's top ten teams for the fourth consecutive year, an
11 accomplishment that has occurred twice in the school's history; and

12 WHEREAS, the Bulldogs were guided to their outstanding success by the able leadership of
13 Head Coach Mark Richt, who was named the SEC Coach of the Year for the second time in
14 the last four years; and

15 WHEREAS, the University of Georgia Bulldogs Football Team has brought great honor to
16 its school and state through its extraordinary win at the Southeastern Conference
17 Championship.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 join in commending the University of Georgia Football Team on winning the 2005
20 Southeastern Conference Championship and congratulate its players and coaches on their
21 outstanding athletic accomplishments.
