A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Clayton Andrew Cumbee on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Clayton "Clay" Andrew Cumbee, of Boy Scout Troop 879 in Fitzgerald,
3 Georgia, has earned the rank of Eagle Scout, which will be awarded to him at an Eagle Court
4 of Honor in March, 2006; and

6 badges, 12 of which are mandatory for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and

9 the many special skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
11 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
12 becoming of an Eagle Scout; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in a world which all too often seems to dwell on the negative aspects of the
14 actions of young people, it is especially fitting and proper for this body to recognize the
15 outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 commend Clayton Andrew Cumbee for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
18 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
19 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
