13 actions of our youth, it is especially fitting and proper for this body to recognize the
14 outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 commend Wade Everett Holcombe for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
17 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
18 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
