- 11 WHEREAS, in a world which all too often seems to dwell on the negative aspects of the
12 actions of young people, it is especially fitting and proper for this body to recognize the
13 outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.

15 commend Joe Hibbitts for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded
