## A RESOLUTION

1 Proclaiming March 5, 2006, as the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church Day in the State  
2 of Georgia; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church, under the leadership of its founder  
4 and pastor the Reverend James Allen Milner, celebrates 30 years of Christian ministry and  
5 service on March 5, 2006; and

6 WHEREAS, the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church is founded upon a commitment  
7 to make a difference in the lives of people by demonstrating the love of Christ through  
8 Christian services; and

9 WHEREAS, the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church has grown and evolved, first  
10 worshiping in the P. J. Woods Center for the Blind, later at 3445 Martin Luther King Jr.  
11 Drive, and now at 875 Cascade Avenue; and

12 WHEREAS, the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church exemplifies in its ministries and  
13 instills in its members the values of Christian stewardship, spiritual leadership, social  
14 responsibility, and community involvement; and

15 WHEREAS, the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church compassionately serves the  
16 homeless in our community through outreach by Community Concerns, Incorporated and its  
17 subsidiaries, Odyssey III and Safe Haven; and

18 WHEREAS, the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church works in partnership with the First  
19 Congregational Church to operate the Ellis Street Shelter for women and children; and

20 WHEREAS, for 30 years, the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church has worked diligently  
21 to live out the mandate of Christian service found in Matthew 25:31- 46 to feed the hungry,  
22 to clothe the naked, and to visit the sick and imprisoned.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
2 proclaim March 5, 2006, as the Chapel of Christian Love Baptist Church Day in Georgia.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
4 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Reverend James Allen Milner.
