## A RESOLUTION

1 Commemorating the 35th anniversary of the founding of the DeKalb County Community  
2 Human Relations Commission; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Community Human Relations Commission (CHRC) is  
4 celebrating its 35th anniversary; and

5 WHEREAS, formed in 1970 by the General Assembly of Georgia, the CHRC strives to  
6 promote, encourage, and develop equal treatment and opportunities for all residents of  
7 DeKalb County and is composed of 22 volunteer members that represent the county's ethnic,  
8 racial, cultural, religious, and economic diversity; and

9 WHEREAS, the commission carries out its mission by investigating and working toward  
10 solutions to problems related to human and community relations and by serving as a liaison  
11 between DeKalb citizens and county government; and

12 WHEREAS, the CHRC serves DeKalb County by holding town hall and neighborhood  
13 meetings and workshops for members, along with regular CHRC meetings; and

14 WHEREAS, this laudable entity's dedication to equality is making DeKalb County a better  
15 place for all to live, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that this body appropriately  
16 recognize the important work of the DeKalb County Community Human Relations  
17 Commission.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 the members of this body commemorate the DeKalb County Community Human Relations  
20 Commission's 35th anniversary and thank all of the commission's members for the invaluable  
21 work they do on behalf of all DeKalb County citizens.
