10	4, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 3505), is amended by striking and reserving paragraphs (1), (5), (9),		
11	(10), (11), and (12) of subsection (a) of Section 1 and by inserting a new subsection at the		
12	end of Section 1 to read as follows:		
13	"(c)(1) Beginning May 1, 2006 through April 30, 2007, the following officials of		
14	Richmond County, Georgia, shall receive an annual salary, payable from the funds of		
15	Richmond County, Georgia, as follows:		
16	(A) Clerk of superior court and state court		
17	(B) Solicitor of the state court 90,000.00

22	(2) Beginning May 1, 2007, and thereafter, the following officials of Richmond County,
