The House Committee on Motor Vehicles offers the following substitute to HB 1392:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 uniform rules of the road, so as to provide for certain penalties for a driver who commits a
- 3 right of way violation resulting in a collision with a motorcyclist, pedestrian, or bicyclist; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to uniform rules
- 8 of the road, is amended by adding a new Code Section 40-6-77 to read as follows:
- 9 "40-6-77.
- 10 Any person who causes an injury to another person as a result of a collision with a
- motorcyclist, bicyclist, or pedestrian by committing any right of way violation under this
- chapter when such motorcyclist, bicyclist, or pedestrian is abiding by the provisions of this
- title shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than
- \$250.00 in addition to any other penalties stipulated by law. For purposes of this Code
- section, injury shall mean causing bodily harm to another by depriving him or her of a
- member of his or her body, by rendering a member of his or her body useless, by seriously
- disfiguring his or her body or a member thereof, or by causing organic brain damage which
- renders the body or any member thereof useless."
- 19 SECTION 2.
- 20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
