A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Peach County High School Trojans football team for winning the Class
2 AAA state football championship; and for other purposes.

4 High School quarterback Antonio Henton and wide receiver Chris Slaughter came out after
5 halftime in the Class AAA championship game against Dougherty Comprehensive High
6 School and did the only thing they know how to do: score touchdowns, giving the Trojans
