3 service to Georgia Power Company and Southern Company; and

5 1970; and
- 6 WHEREAS, since 1995, he has served as executive vice president of external affairs for  
7 Georgia Power Company, where he has been responsible for coordinating activities in  
8 Community and Economic Development, Corporate Communication, Environmental Affairs,  
9 Governmental and Regulatory Affairs, and Land; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Archer has contributed generously of his time and efforts to numerous  
11 professional and civic organizations, serving on the boards of the Georgia Power Foundation,  
12 the Atlanta Sports Council, the University of Georgia Athletic Association, and the Georgia  
13 World Congress Center Authority, where he was chairman, and has been an enthusiastic  
14 member of the Georgia Conservancy, Clean Air Campaign, the Nature Conservancy, and the  
15 Heritage and Wildlife Conservation Council; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Archer's business and community leadership have contributed greatly to  
17 the success of his employer and the well-being of this state, and he has always exhibited the  
18 highest degree of character and integrity.
