ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide for a retirement income
- 2 exclusion of \$75,000.00 for taxpayers 62 years of age or older and an exclusion of the first
- 3 \$100,000.00 of income from any source for taxpayers 70 years of age or older; to provide for
- 4 the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article VII of the Constitution is amended by adding a new section immediately following
- 8 Section IIA, to be designated Section IIB, to read as follows:

9 "SECTION IIB.

10 INCOME TAX EXCLUSIONS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

- Paragraph I. *Income taxation; exclusions*. For taxable years beginning on or after
- January 1, 2009, retirement income from any source of taxpayers 62 years of age or older
- shall be excluded from Georgia taxable net income in the amount of \$75,000.00. For
- taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2009, the first \$100,000.00 of income from
- any source of taxpayers 70 years of age or older shall be excluded from Georgia taxable
- 16 net income."

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 19 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 20 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 21 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide for a
- retirement income exclusion of \$75,000.00 for taxpayers 62 years of age
- 23 () NO or older and an exclusion of the first \$100,000.00 of income from any
- source for taxpayers 70 years of age or older?"

- 3 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 4 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
