- 17 Edward Pothast, Joseph Sharp, Ernest Lawson, Reginald Marsh, and A.L. Ripley; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Director Aaron Berger, who has also served as a member of the board of
- 19 directors of the Arts Leadership League of Georgia, has demonstrated exemplary leadership
- and been the driving force of excellence for this fine institution.
