A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Captain Jason P. Ball; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put
3 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the
4 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and

5 WHEREAS, Captain Jason P. Ball has long been recognized by the citizens of this nation for
6 the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the
7 welfare of the citizens of the United States; and

8 WHEREAS, this extraordinary man has diligently and conscientiously served his country
9 with honor and distinction for the past eight years as a member of the United States Army
10 Corps of Engineers where he is the Commander of Alpha Company of the 648th Engineer

17 spirit and willpower, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding
