8	Code Section 48-5-40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
9	regarding property tax exemptions, is amended by striking paragraph (1) and inserting in its
10	place a new paragraph (1) to read as follows:
11	"(1) 'Applicant' means <u>a person who is</u> :
12	(A)(i) A married individual living with his spouse;
13	(B)(ii) An individual who is unmarried but who permanently maintains a home for
14	the benefit of one or more other individuals who are related to such individual or
15	dependent wholly or partially upon such individual for support;
16	(C)(iii) An individual who is widowed having one or more children and maintaining
17	a home occupied by himself and the child or children;
18	(D)(iv) A divorced individual living in a bona fide state of separation and having
19	legal custody of one or more children, when the divorced individual owns and
20	maintains a home for the child or children; or
21	(E)(v) An individual who is unmarried or is widowed and who permanently
22	maintains a home owned and occupied by himself.: and
23	(B) Who is a resident of this state as defined in paragraph (15) of Code Section
24	<u>40-5-1, as amended."</u>
