## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 16, 2006, as Columbus Day at the Capitol; and for other purposes.

- 2 WHEREAS, Georgia has been very blessed to have had the wonderful City of Columbus in
- 3 its midst for over 175 years; and
- 4 WHEREAS, at the direction of the Georgia Legislature, Columbus was founded on the east

5 bank of the Chattahoochee River and chartered as a city in 1828; and

6 WHEREAS, a textile center for most of its history until the 1970s, Columbus is today home

- 7 the world headquarters of Aflac, TSYS credit card processing, Synovus Banking, Carmike
- 8 Cinemas, Japanese battery manufacturing company MBIA, Pratt & Whitney, and numerous
- 9 other thriving businesses; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in 1971, the former City of Columbus and Muscogee County consolidated to
- 11 form the Columbus Consolidated Government, the first such government in Georgia and then
- 12 one of only a handful in the nation; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Columbus is a center for the arts, with the RiverCenter for the Performing Arts,
- 14 the Springer Opera House (Georgia's Official State Theatre), and Columbus State
- 15 University's music, art, and theater campuses all clustered in the city's Uptown area; and
- WHEREAS, what most makes this city so special is its diverse, value-minded citizens, whoare proud of Columbus's rich heritage and great promise for the future.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
  join in recognizing March 16, 2006, as Columbus Day at the Capitol.
