## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Operation One Voice and its Special Operations Forces Run; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Operation One Voice is a nonprofit corporation dedicated to honoring the men  
4 and women serving as members of the elite Special Operations Forces of the United States  
5 Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps and raising funds for the needs of children of  
6 fallen Special Operations Forces members; and

7 WHEREAS, in tribute to the brave and resolute individuals who risk their lives as members  
8 of Special Operations Forces to defend our nation and our liberty, patriotic citizens and  
9 public safety employees of Georgia and Florida are planning an honorary, around-the-clock  
10 run to deliver to designated military officials at Busch Gardens in Tampa Bay, Florida, on  
11 Veterans' Day, November 11, 2006, funds to assist the children and families of fallen  
12 members of Special Operations Forces, and a commemorative series of "honor coins" to be  
13 given to members of Special Operations Forces, their families, and their commanders; and

14 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia takes pride in honoring the steadfast men and women of  
15 the United States Armed Services, who have answered the call to defend our nation and our  
16 freedom; and

17 WHEREAS, the courageous, honorable men and women serving in the Armed Forces of the  
18 United States work around the clock on land, sea, and in the air to protect the liberty of  
19 Americans and to protect life and the promise of democracy around the globe.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
21 commend Operation One Voice and the volunteers participating in the Special Operations  
22 Forces Run.
