A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise
3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of
4 adjournment for the 2006 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of
5 March 21, 2006, through March 27, 2006, shall be as follows:

- 6 Tuesday, March 21 in adjournment
- 7 Wednesday, March 22 in session for legislative day 35
- 8 Thursday, March 23 in session for legislative day 36
- 9 Friday, March 24 in session for legislative day 37
- 10 Saturday, March 25 in adjournment
- 11 Sunday, March 26 in adjournment
- 12 Monday, March 27 in session for legislative day 38

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after March 27, 2006, the periods of adjournment
14 of the 2006 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General
15 Assembly, except that for the remainder of the 2006 regular session, unless otherwise
16 provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close of the
17 legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall
18 reconvene on the following Monday.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for
20 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the
21 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
