AS PASSED SENATE

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act providing for the appointment of the chief magistrate of Clayton County,
2 approved March 26, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 4411), as amended, particularly by an Act
3 approved April 2, 1998 (Ga. L. 1998, p. 4262), so as to provide a salary for the chief
4 magistrate, to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act providing for the appointment of the chief magistrate of Clayton County, approved
8 March 26, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 4411), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April
9 2, 1998 (Ga. L. 1998, p. 4262), is amended by striking in its entirety Subsection (f) of
10 Section 2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

11 "(f) The chief magistrate of Clayton County shall receive a salary in the amount of
12 \$115,460.00 paid in equal monthly installments from county funds."

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2006.

15 **SECTION 3.**

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
