#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Bryan H. Digby on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Bryan H. Digby, a Boy Scout from Troop 503, has earned the distinguished  
3 rank of Eagle Scout; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among  
5 the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed  
7 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities  
8 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Bryan H. Digby has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers that he  
10 possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and
- 11 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are  
12 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

14 himself but also to his family and troop.
