A RESOLUTION

1 Commending James Christopher Harrell on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, James Christopher Harrell has earned the rank of Eagle Scout, to be awarded
4 during an Eagle Scout Court of Honor on March 19, 2006; and

5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among
6 the Boy Scouts of America; and

7 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
8 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
9 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and

10 WHEREAS, James Christopher Harrell has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and
11 peers that he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and

12 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are
13 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

14 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, James Christopher Harrell has brought honor
15 not only to himself but also to his family and troop.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize and commend James Christopher Harrell for his diligence and dedication in
18 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on
19 attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
