A RESOLUTION

1 Remembering and honoring Mr. Fred Kelley Harvey, Jr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Fred Kelley "Ted" Harvey, Jr., was born on July 17, 1944, to Julia Conn
3 Morton Harvey and Fred K. Harvey, Sr., and spent his childhood in Louisville, Georgia; and

4 WHEREAS, he received his undergraduate degree and his law degree from the University
5 of Georgia, graduating in the top five percent from both classes and serving with distinction
6 on the school's law review; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Harvey enjoyed a highly successful legal career, beginning with his tenure
8 with the Augusta firm of Sanders, Hester, Holley, Ashmore, and Boozer, a firm that was
9 headed by former Governor Carl Sanders and where Mr. Harvey eventually became partner,
10 and continuing when in 1987 he formed Abbot, Murphy, and Harvey in his hometown of
11 Louisville; and

12 WHEREAS, devoting most of his practice to commercial and business matters, Mr. Harvey
13 was able to travel throughout the United States and abroad as he represented several high
14 profile clients, including the Georgia Industrial Loan Association, Fulghum Fibres, Inc.,
15 Fulghum Industries, Inc., Jefferson Energy Cooperative, Jefferson Hospital, and
16 Queensborough National Bank & Trust Company; and

17 WHEREAS, outside of his busy career, Mr. Harvey was an avid gardener, well known for
18 his gorgeous roses and his crop of Southern Living tomatoes that he would often share with
19 family and friends, as well as an enthusiastic golfer and hunter; and

20 WHEREAS, he was also famous in Louisville for his love of Christmas, sometimes leaving
21 his tree up until spring because he did not want to let go of the holiday spirit, and as one of
22 the most passionate "Bull Dawg" supporters in Georgia; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Harvey was a faithful member of the Louisville United Methodist Church,
2 where he served on the stewardship committee; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Harvey leaves behind a loving and devoted family, including his wife,
4 Mary Virginia Price Harvey, and his three sons, Thomas C. Harvey, Jeffrey C. Harvey, and
5 William H. Harvey; and

6 WHEREAS, Georgia lost a most estimable citizen on February 10, 2006, with the passing
7 of Mr. Fred Kelley Harvey, Jr.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
9 the members of this body join in remembering and honoring the life of Mr. Fred Kelley
10 Harvey, Jr., in expressing their deepest sorrow at his passing, and in extending their most
11 heartfelt condolences to his family and friends.
