A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 17-6-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees

2 of sureties, so as to change the basis of the bondsmen's fees; to provide for related matters;

3 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.** 6 Code Section 17-6-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees of sureties, 7 is amended by striking subsection (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "(a) Sureties on criminal bonds in any court shall not charge or receive more than 12 8 9 percent of the principal amount of bonds face amount of the bond set in the amount of 10 \$10,000.00 or less, which amount includes the principal and all applicable surcharges, and 11 shall not charge or receive more than 15 percent of the principal amount of bonds face 12 amount of the bond set in an amount in excess of \$10,000.00, which amount includes the principal and all applicable surcharges, as compensation from defendants or from anyone 13 14 acting for defendants."

SECTION 2.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
