A RESOLUTION

- 1 Remembering and honoring the life of Sergeant Bryan Lewis; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, throughout his life, Sergeant Bryan Lewis of Athens, Georgia, touched
3 countless lives with his generosity, compassion, and unwavering love of country; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Sergeant Lewis, a native of Bunkie, Louisiana, enlisted in the United States
5 Army in 1993 and served with distinction with the 258th Military Police Company, 519th
6 Military Police Battalion, based at Fort Polk, Louisiana; and
- 7 WHEREAS, his illustrious military career took him to locales across the globe, including
8 Kosovo, Bosnia, Germany, Korea, and Cuba, before he was deployed to Iraq last year; and
- 9 WHEREAS, a newlywed, Sergeant Lewis was devoted to his wife of seven months, Fabersha
10 Flynt Lewis, and managed to speak with her every day of his deployment; and
- 11 WHEREAS, on March 13, 2006, Sergeant Lewis was killed in a roadside bomb explosion
12 in Iraq; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Sergeant Lewis will be posthumously awarded the Bronze Star for combat
14 heroism and meritorious service; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia, its citizens, and the members of this body have been
16 greatly moved and saddened at the passing of this courageous, kind, and gifted gentleman,
17 and all Americans mourn his loss and honor the sacrifice he made to defend the liberty of this
18 great nation.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 join to remember and honor the life and sacrifice of Sergeant Bryan Lewis and extend their
21 most heartfelt condolences to his family and friends.
