A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Paul Andrew Thornton on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Paul Andrew Thornton of Boy Scout Troop 89 in Powder Springs, Georgia, has
3 earned the rank of Eagle Scout, which will be awarded to him in an Eagle Scout Court of
4 Honor on May 7, 2006; and

5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among
6 the Boy Scouts of America; and

7 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
8 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
9 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and

11 that he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and

12 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are
13 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

14 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Paul Andrew Thornton has brought honor not
15 only to himself but also to his family and troop.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body recognize and commend Paul Andrew Thornton for his diligence
18 and dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and
19 congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
