7 Alumnus Award in 1996; and

8 WHEREAS, Bill Oettmeier, Jr., was Big Jayhook of the Warnell School of Forestry and 9 Natural Resources Jayhole Club in 1990 and was elected an honorary member of the 10 University of Georgia AGHON Society; and

WHEREAS, Bill Oettmeier, Jr., was commended by the United States Selective ServiceSystem for his support of military operations of Joint Reserve Forces Detachment 2-7; and
