- 2 Emergency Medical Services Week; and for other purposes.

- 10 WHEREAS, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and
- 11 recovery rate of persons stricken with sudden illness or injury; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Georgia's emergency medical services system is celebrating its thirty-third year
- of service in 2006.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 15 this body commends Georgia's first responders, emergency medical technicians, cardiac
- 16 technicians, and paramedics for their outstanding service to the people of this state and
- 17 recognizes May 14 through May 20, 2006, as Emergency Medical Services Week.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 19 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Courtney Terwilliger,
- 20 President of the Georgia Association of Emergency Medical Services, and David Bean,
- 21 Director of the Georgia Office of Emergency Medical Services of the Department of Human
- 22 Resources, Division of Public Health.
