A RESOLUTION

3 than Mrs. Dorothy "Sue" Lindstrom, who, along with her loving husband of 40 years, Daniel
4 Lindstrom, has opened her home and her heart to 88 foster children; and

6 a 12 year old girl while Mrs. Lindstrom was caring for her own two biological toddlers; and

9 ethnic backgrounds and ages, many of whom have suffered from physical or mental

12 heartbreaking backgrounds of emotional or physical abuse, children that the Lindstrom
13 family has always strived to serve by making them feel loved, wanted, and protected; and

14 WHEREAS, Mrs. Lindstrom has proudly seen her foster children achieve many great
15 personal accomplishments, including several who have gone on to college or who have found
16 productive vocations; and

17 WHEREAS, in her unwavering devotion to the young people under her care, Mrs. Lindstrom
18 and her husband have adopted 14 children with special needs; and

19 WHEREAS, this incredible lady is truly an inspiration to people everywhere who seek to
20 make this world a better place for children.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
2 join in commending Mrs. Dorothy "Sue" Lindstrom for her many years of extraordinary
3 service as a foster mother and in extending their very best wishes for happiness and
