A RESOLUTION

1 Commending those Georgia State University law students who served as the first Speaker's
2 Law Student Externs during the 2006 regular session; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Georgia State University School of Law and its faculty and staff are a great
4 resource of the State of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the Honorable Glenn Richardson, Speaker of the House of Representatives, was
6 a member of the first graduating class of the Georgia State University School of Law; and

7 WHEREAS, Speaker Richardson wanted to organize a program of practical legislative
8 experience as a part of the curriculum of the Georgia State University School of Law in
9 conjunction with the regular session of the General Assembly; and

10 WHEREAS, in order to establish this relationship between the legislature and the Georgia
11 State University School of Law, Speaker Richardson inaugurated the Speaker's Law Student
12 Extern Program during the 2006 regular session of the General Assembly; and

13 WHEREAS, Lindsey Napier, Clay O'Daniel, and Mary Lewis, three intrepid senior law
14 students from Georgia State University, were chosen to be the inaugural Speaker's Law
15 Student Externs; and

16 WHEREAS, these three students were required to read and digest the Rules, Ethics and
17 Decorum of the House of Representatives, as well as various portions of the Georgia
18 Constitution, Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure, and the Official Code of Georgia
19 Annotated prior to beginning their externship; and

20 WHEREAS, during the session these students spent many hours attending committee
21 meetings, reading legislation, discussing policy issues, and meeting with legislators in
22 addition to maintaining a full course of study at the law school; and

1 WHEREAS, each of these students has performed in an exemplary manner, demonstrating
2 professional skills that reflect the quality of the legal education they are receiving at the
3 Georgia State University School of Law and their own dedication and commitment to their
4 chosen profession; and

5 WHEREAS, the members of the standing committees and legislative leaders have benefited
6 greatly from the service of these law students and salute each of them on a job well done.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
8 this body commends the first Speaker's Law School Externs for their superb performance
9 during the 2006 regular session and conveys its best wishes to them for success in their future
10 pursuits.

12 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to each of the Speaker's Law
