- 1 Commending those Georgia State University law students who served as the first Speaker's
- 2 Law Student Externs during the 2006 regular session; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Georgia State University School of Law and its faculty and staff are a great
- 4 resource of the State of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Honorable Glenn Richardson, Speaker of the House of Representatives, was
- 6 a member of the first graduating class of the Georgia State University School of Law; and

- 20 WHEREAS, during the session these students spent many hours attending committee
- 21 meetings, reading legislation, discussing policy issues, and meeting with legislators in
- addition to maintaining a full course of study at the law school; and
